

Dear student and parent,

Welcome to 7th grade health. My name is Mr. Handley and I will be your child's 7<sup>th</sup> grade health teacher for the 2009-2010 school year. Following is a list of supplies and classroom regulations required from your student for my specific classroom.

**SUPPLIES:** In order for each student to get the most from my class, students will need the following materials.

1. White notebook paper (wide or college ruled)
2. A folder to hold and organize all work (2 pocket folder)
3. Plenty of pencils and blue or black pens
4. 70-100 page spiral notebook (journal) to record notes

Additional supplies may be needed throughout the year.

**Health Textbook:** We will work out of a classroom set of textbooks. Students may sign out a textbook (short or long term use) if needed at any time.

**GRADES** for this course will be determined by the following:

1. Classroom assignments/homework will count for 1/3 of the grade. All assignments will be posted on my teacher's page at [www.springfieldspartans.org](http://www.springfieldspartans.org).
2. Quizzes and tests will count for 1/3 of the grade.
3. Note taking (journal) will count for 1/3 of the grade. All notes will be posted on my teacher's page at [www.springfieldspartans.org](http://www.springfieldspartans.org).
4. Classroom participation, behavior, attendance, and possible extra credit will also factor into the grade.
5. I DO NOT ACCEPT LATE WORK. LATE WORK= 0 POINTS

**GENERAL CLASSROOM RULES:**

1. Students must be in the classroom when the bell rings
2. Students must be prepared with completed assignments and class supplies.
3. Students must raise their hand and wait to be called on if he/she has a question or comment to share.
4. When someone is speaking, the rest of the class will remain quiet and courteous.
